

## Manual for use of document types for export



## Goods in containers/trailers that are delivered to the Dutch ports for export must be included in the terminal administration.

You can communicate this information to the terminal through our service Notification Export Documentation. This manual will assist you in passing on the correct document type and document number, so that the goods in the container/trailer can be delivered to the terminal.

15. Emergency procedure final export from the Union for an ECS declaration	REX	REX followed by the EORI number of the declaring party.  In case of multiple declarations, a letter must be added, e.g. A, B, AA, AB etc.	Yes	In writing
16. Emergency procedure final export from the Union for an NCTS declaration	RTR	RTR followed by a unique number for the NCTS declaration.  In a simplified procedure for authorisation holders, the declarant creates this number himself. In the normal procedure, the number is created by Customs.	Yes	In writing
17. ATA transit carnet	ATA	Unique sequence number of the ATA carnet.	Yes	ATA in writing
18. Tank container with residue statement (Empty uncleaned tank containers with residue)	TNK	EORI number exporter.	No	Not applicable
